Honors College members intending to participate in organized study abroad programs prior to graduation are invited to apply for financial support provided through the Honors College study abroad scholarship programs. These programs are:

INTERNATIONAL STUDY AWARD**

This award is made possible by a major contribution from Jeffrey and Kathryn Cole. Up to fifty awards, usually \$500 and \$1,000 but some as large as \$4,000, will be made each year to help defray the expenses incurred by studying abroad.

**JOHN A. AND IRMA L. BENSCHOP  
INTERNATIONAL ENRICHMENT AWARD  
(FOR STUDY ABROAD)**

This award is made possible by a major contribution from Beryl Benschop Johnson and her husband Edward A. Johnson, along with contributions from the MSU Dean of International Studies and Programs and numerous Honors College alumni. Two to four awards of \$500 each will be made each year to help defray travel expenses.

How to apply: The application process involves completion of the Honors College Scholarship/Fellowship Application Form.

When to apply: The deadline for those participating in summer, fall, or academic-year programs is **March 1**; for winter break and spring programs, the deadline is **October 15**.

Criteria: The amount of each award will depend on the quality of the proposal and on the academic record of the proposer as well as the length of the intended stay abroad. Students who go on MSU-sponsored programs will be given preference, but those planning to enroll in programs sponsored by other universities may also apply. Applications from students who have never studied or traveled abroad are particularly welcome. Preference may be given to students who do not have other substantial scholarships.

Selection process: All those completing the Honors College Scholarship/Fellowship Application Form will constitute the pool from which the recipients of these awards will be selected. A faculty/Honors College committee will screen the applications and make a recommendation to the Dean of the Honors College. Applicants will be notified of the results no later than April 15.
