

# University Integrative Studies – Substitution Summary

For Honors College members, disciplinary courses *replace* the University Integrative Studies requirement. The Tier I Writing requirement can be fulfilled by WRA 195H or an approved substitution course. This summary provides a starting point for planning substitution courses for IAH, ISS, ISB and ISP, but is not an exhaustive list. Note that any substitution course requires approval from an HC Advisor using the online request form in the Honors College Academic Progress Plan (HCAPP.)

✓ **HONORS SECTIONS in IAH, ISS, ISB and ISP ARE acceptable in fulfilling University Integrative Studies.**

X **HONORS OPTIONS in Integrative Studies courses will NOT fulfill University Integrative Studies requirements.**

**1 course in WRITING - WRA 195H or an approved departmental course in consultation with an HC Advisor - should cover composition, critical reading and research skill development.**

- Substitution courses must be 3-4 credits and above the introductory level.
- Courses that are **not** acceptable: skill-based/practice-based (i.e. music performance, language-learning); research methodology; required on the primary degree
